Leading cryptocurrency Bitcoin finally managed to climb above the \$50,000 mark and hold the area on multiple time frames. The token saw an impressive pump of over 10% on Wednesday, as the coin climbed to \$52,600.



Bitcoin hit a new two-week high before seeing a slight correction, which is still holding over the vital support line at \$50,000.

Someone Transferred 5 BTC Worth \$234,000 To Fake 'Elon Musk' Giveaway Wallet



According to a recent tweet by Whale Alert, someone transferred 5 BTC worth a staggering \$234,000 in current market price to a verified scam address pretending to be that of Elon Musk .

Other top businessmen like Richard Branson, Bill Gates have seen their faces used to commit fraudulent activities. Even popular brands have also seen their accounts used to defraud the investing public.

In a June.9 report published by Bleeping Computer, several scammers hacked legitimate YouTube accounts and impersonated as rocket company Space X to defraud victims. The hacked accounts were recreated to look like Elon Musk's Space X, and the fraudsters hosted Bitcoin giveaways for 80,000 who tuned in. Their effort was rewarded with \$150,000 coming into their pockets.

Musk has told his viewers to be careful whom they send money to in hopes of getting rich. He also said that Twitter was a viable incubator for these scams to grow.

Nigerian educational system must refocus – Ex-VP Namadi Sambo

According to Namadi Sambo, Nigerian universities must refocus on building of graduates that will create and end poverty among the people and ultimately close the wide social inequality and promote social coefficient in the communities.

“As a nation, we must focus our educational system to one that shifts to prepare our students in different skills set; the one that empowers and creates job, rather for low pay jobs that has no value for nation building in the competitive world.

“We must pay attention on building skilled graduates that can provide jobs not only for themselves, but for others.

“No doubt, Igbinedion University must set the pace for providing value adding education in line with global best practice,” he said.

Sambo linked the prevailing insecurity in the country to the massive job deficit, which he said had translated to the increase in poverty and restiveness among the youth.

He described as apt and timely the theme of the matriculation lecture: “Refocusing Value Driven Education in the Digital Age Through the Lens of Entrepreneurship, Enterprise and Global Competitiveness: Lessons for Nigeria”.

He said there was no better time to discuss value driven education in a vast changing world that shifts its focus on skills set demand than now.

“With the disruption in world economy due to COVID-19 pandemic and continuous search for job opportunities across the globe

particularly in Africa, our education system must be value driven," said the erstwhile governor of Kaduna state.

He however commended Igbinedion University for its continuing partnership with renowned actors and global players in the Information and Communication Technology such as CISCO Academy, Microsoft Academy, Mikrotik and Huawei, among others.

This, he said, was in line with the university policies in digital literacy and setting standards by producing change agents and job creators instead of job seekers.

"I am also aware that this university has been adopted by the NUC as a model for a nationwide entrepreneurial skill acquisition programme for Nigerian universities.

"This great effort of this institution deserves the support of all and sundry especially at this critical time that high unemployment rate continuous to pose greater challenges to our existence as a nation.

Sambo urged the new students to make their parents and this great nation proud by dedicating their precious time and effort to study, advising them to take advantage of the conducive settings and standards provided by the institution.

The Guest Speaker, Mr Justice Derefaka, stressed the need for the Nigerian education system to respond to the global change.

Derefaka, the Technical Adviser on Gas Business and Policy Implementation to the Minister of State for Petroleum Resources, said that Nigeria was ranked low in graduates with requisite skills, experience and knowledge required by employing industries.

Nigeria, he said, needed to adopt strategies in educational reform to pick race with the accelerated technological changes by closing gaps and infuse a methodology and selection of instructional materials on curriculum for retainer system.

He corroborated the position of the former vice president that Nigerian students must be prepared well for the future in the area of creative thinking on how to create jobs rather than searching for white collar jobs.

Earlier, Prof. Lawrence Ezemonye, the Vice-Chancellor of the premier private university in Nigeria, said that the institution has continued to champion higher education revolution through innovation, entrepreneur and research since its establishment 22 years ago.

Why Nigeria is king of cryptocurrency trading



More cryptocurrency trading goes on in Nigeria than almost anywhere else in the world, reflecting a loss of faith in more traditional forms of investment, as Ijeoma Ndukwe reports.

According to the BBC, Tola Fadugbagbe recalls moving to Lagos from his small south-western town 10 years ago with dreams of brighter prospects.

Instead, the 34-year-old ended up in a series of odd jobs earning the minimum wage to survive – a typical story for many young Nigerians who are just trying to get by.

It was not until 2016 that online adverts for Bitcoin piqued his interest and he began his cryptocurrency journey.

“I started intensive research,” Mr Fadugbagbe told the BBC.

“I was spending hours every day watching videos on YouTube and reading articles about Bitcoin. I didn’t have much money so I started with \$100 to \$200.”

It was a decision that transformed his life.

At the time that we spoke, Mr Fadugbagbe, who now trades full time and teaches budding investors, said he had cryptocurrency worth more than \$200,000 (£140,000) in his possession.

“I’ll soon be moving into my own house, which I’m building. I have a farm – a very big one – courtesy of cryptocurrency,” he laughs gleefully, unencumbered by concerns that he could be inflating an investment bubble that will one day burst.

“No Nigerian comes to cryptocurrency and wants to look back. It’s a big opportunity.”

Success stories like Mr Fadugbagbe’s have attracted millions of Nigerians to digital currencies such as Bitcoin.

A 2020 survey by data platform Statista revealed that 32% of Nigerians are users of cryptocurrencies – the highest proportion of any country in the world.

Bitcoin: Elon Musk's profile update sends the crypto on a short bull run

It was suggested that a new profile of Elon Musk that spotted the bitcoin hashtag is responsible for the latest bull run in the price of the largest cryptocurrency in the world.

The price of Bitcoin on Friday 29/1/21 morning jumped to over \$37,000, about 10.2 percent rise in less than an hour following the profile update. The World's richest man and CEO of Tesla is followed by 43.8 million Twitter users. He also has a growing reputation for making market-moving comments on the site.

It was also Musk's tweet "Gamestonk" along with a link to the Reddit Wallstreetbets stock trading discussion group tweet on Tuesday that set off the retail trading frenzy for GameStop

Corp which saw its share price surge by 50 percent.

The price of bitcoin has risen by over 300 percent last year, as some of the world's biggest corporations sought exposure to cryptocurrency. The price hit an all-time high of \$42,000 last in recent weeks.

The Musk may be short-lived as the price of bitcoin has since retreated to \$36,663.

Broda Shaggi, Mr Macaroni others top list of digital content creators



Africa Polling Institute (API), a research institute based in Abuja has listed popular comedians Broda Shaggi, Mark Angel Comedy, Mr Macaroni, and Taaoma as Nigeria's top skit comedians and digital content creators.

Lasisi Elenu, MC Casino, Nedu Mallam Musa, Woli Agba, Omo Ibadan and Bosho also made the top ten list.

The Executive Director of the institute, Bell Chua, who disclosed this while addressing newsmen in Abuja, said that the findings were derived from a survey that sampled opinions of no fewer than 1,521 Nigerians.

According to him, the survey which was conducted between October and November 2020, was done using a stratified random sampling technique in selecting the respondents.

He added that the report, titled "Skit Economy: An Assessment of Digital Content Creators in Nigeria", sought the views of Nigerians regarding the rise of comedy skits, their viewership, and who they considered their top skit comedians in the country.

The executive director noted that the study represented a novel attempt to understand 'a seemingly under-research space', which had so far contributed to the economic growth of the nation and the mental wellbeing of citizens.

"From the study, we found out that 67 per cent of Nigerians say they watch comedy skits, with 45 per cent saying they watch them once in a while and 29 per cent a few times a week.

"65 per cent of Nigerians consider comedy skits funny and entertaining, while 20 per cent consider them quite informative.

"An average of 88 per cent of Nigerians agree that comedy skits are useful in creating awareness on social trends, correcting societal ills, and creating job opportunities," he said.

Mr Ihua added that the study also sampled the views of some skit comedians and producers. He said the findings revealed that the lack of financial assistance from the government and private sector were identified as key issues bedevilling the growth of the sector.

According to him, other factors include; high cost of production, poor electricity, and excessive taxes on social media platforms.

"Skit comedians, however, urge the government and private

sector to support them, in order for Nigeria to reap the benefits of showcasing the country's talents, as well as alleviating poverty through the creation of wealth and jobs," he said.

Rummy

It requires a 52-card deck played amongst a group in addition to a Jokers for every deck. An extra deck is then brought into play if there are multiple players (up to 6). The cards in the game are simultaneously picked and discarded that allows players to make sets and groupings from the cards that come during every pick. 



The basic rules of the Indian rummy include a game with 13 cards. At least one deck is required between 2 players and the deck can be increased depending on the number of players participation in it. Each player is required to draw a card from an open or a closed card deck and then discard one to the closed card deck. To win the game, a player needs to form sets of one pure sequence and one impure sequence.

Poker

Poker is one of the most loved game by the country. The projected value is of the player and the opponent's hand placement. It requires taking a calculated risk, identifying what the next move of the opponent can be and also luck. This game is not only exciting but requires your mind to make strategies to win. There are almost 4 rounds of betting that a player can use to put their chips down.

3-2-5

3-2-5 or Teen Do Paanch is a game that is extremely well known in India and its neighbouring countries. Common amongst all the age groups, this game uses a 30-card deck which can be made by eliminating cards of denominations groups from the standard deck. This altered deck utilized would accordingly incorporate all Aces, Kings, Queens, Jacks, 10's, 9's and 8's. Also, the Seven of Spades and Seven of Hearts are added to the deck.

There are each of the 10 moves that need to be played, the players at that point decide whether they figured out how to succeed at least the same number of moves as needed under the standards for the game (three, two or five).

Satte-pe-Satta

Very fun and easy game, Satte-pe-Satta requires you to get rid of all the cards that you have as soon as possible. With no definite rules or points to remember, this game is a fun activity which can be played with people of all age groups and can still be a lot of fun. Some ground rules require the players to discard all the cards but in a pattern. A standard 52 cards deck is used to play this game and it can be played amongst 3-8 players.

A person is initially chosen as the dealer for a particular round who then distributes cards in an unbiased manner. The first player that has the 7 hearts begin by keeping his card upside down on the table. The person getting rid of all his cards is declared the winner and the other player(s) left have the negative points equivalent to the number of cards left with them at the end of every match.
